Dear Mr. Drennan:

In full and final settlement of the IHB Wage Modification Agreement dated March 3, 1983, and subsequently executed by the UTU-T on February 6, 1984.

IT IS AGREED:

- 1. Effective on July 1, 1984, the basic daily rate of pay, in effect on June 30, 1984 shall be increased by four (4) percent.
- 2. Effective on July 1, 1985, the remaining wage and cost-of-living increases under the UIU-NRLC National Agreement dated October 15, 1982 shall be applied.

Note: The wage and cost-of-living increases provided for under Item (2) above, shall reflect the National standard daily basic rate applicable to all employees represented by UTU-T.

- 3. The retroactive payments due under Items (1) and (2) hereof shall be paid within sixty (60) days from the effective date of this agreement by special paycheck.
- 4. The wage and cost-of-living increases due under Items (1) and (2) hereof shall be computed so as to ensure proper payment. The General Chairman shall be furnished with a copy of a computerized statement reflecting the method of payment to each employee.

5. In the event the IHB and another labor organization signatory to the IHB Wage Modification Agreement dated March 3, 1983, agrees to a greater percentage of retroactive payment, such percentage shall apply and become applicable to employees represented by UTU-T.
